

Although the exact date is still not definite, the New Jersey Department of Transportation is expecting the Route 46 bridge closure to begin on or around July 9 and anticipate it will last approximately six months.

NJ DOT will hold a **public hearing** on June 24 at Dover High School from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM.

Areas affected will include Denville, Mine Hill, Mount Arlington, Rockaway Borough, Rockaway Township, Roxbury and Wharton. As a result of the closure, motorists should anticipate increased traffic congestion on Route 10 and Route 80.
